
Setting up Occupational Licensing Account Access
(Onboarding for Applicants with and without Occupational Licenses)
Before you begin: Navigate to https://www.dmv.ca.gov/portal/vehicle-industry-services/occupational-licensing/login/ to set up & access your Occupational Licensing Account.




1. Select the Start button

Navigation:

- For Users who already have an Occupational Licensing Account **GO TO PAGE 3.**
- For Users who have an Occupational License but have not yet set up an Occupational Licensing Account, **GO TO PAGE 4**
- For Users who DO NOT have an Occupational License and have not yet set up an Occupational Licensing Account, <u>GO TO PAGE 10</u>




1. Users who already have gone through the onboarding process can select "Login to MyDMV"




- Users who have not yet gone through the onboarding process and need to set up access to an existing Occupational License, select the radio button next to "Yes, I have a current or past license, permit, or agreement for either myself or a business"
- 2. Then choose the button that indicates whether you're setting up access for an Individual, Business, or Both type of Occupational Licenses
- 3. Select whether you have a Driver's License or Identification card in the state of California
- 4. Select Start

If you selected No to Question 3 (indicating that you **DO NOT** have a California issued Driver's license or ID) you'll see the following screen:




- 1. You'll be asked to provide information to validate your identity to gain access to your Occupational License information. Please complete the following fields:


If you selected Yes for Question 3 (indicating that you have a California issued Driver's license or ID) you'll see the following screen:

 - a. Social Security Number
 - b. Date of Birth
 - c. Driver License Number (California DL/ID holders only)
 - d. Individual or Firm Occupational License number
 - e. Email address Important: you <u>must</u> use the same email address associated with your current MyDMV account or create a new MyDMV account using this email address.
 - f. Last name
- 2. Perform the reCAPTCHA task Select I'm not a robot
- 3. Select Submit



- 1. You should receive a success message on the screen, and receive an email from DMV Online Services to confirm you've successfully validated your identification.
- 2. The link provided in the email will take you back to DMV Online Services where you will continue to set up your access.








- 1. Once you log into your MyDMV account, you'll be taken to the Occupational Licensing page. The **My Licenses** link at the top will take you to your licenses.
- 2. You can also access your licenses using the **My Licenses** tile to be taken to your licenses.




- 1. Users who not gone through the onboarding process or set up an Occupational License Account, select the radio button next to "NO, I've never had any licenses, permits, or agreements."
- 2. Select Start

After selecting "NO, I've never had any licenses, permits, or agreements.", you'll see the following screen:




- 1. If you have a CA Driver's License, you'll be asked to provide information to validate your identity to gain access to your Occupational License information. Please complete the following fields:
 - a. Social Security Number
 - b. Date of Birth
 - c. Driver License Number (California DL/ID holders only)
 - d. Individual or Firm Occupational License number
 - e. Email address


If you select the radio button indicating that you **DO NOT** have a California issued Driver's license or ID, you'll see this screen:

 - a. Email address
 - b. Important: you must use the same email address associated with your current MyDMV account or create a new MyDMV account using this email address.
 - c. Last name
- 2. Perform the reCAPTCHA task Select I'm not a robot
- 3. Select Submit






1. Provide and Re-Enter Email




2. A time sensitive email will be sent to the email provided for confirmation.




3. Provide your name & phone number to register and another message will be sent to the number provided (via text or call)



4. Type in the 6 digit code sent to the phone# provided and select Confirm.




5. Complete registration by creating a unique password according to the parameters given.




After completing the creation and registration of a MyDMV Account, you can now Login using your MyDMV account to access Occupational Licensing online services using your email address and password.


